Dear Valued Clients:

We look forward to seeing many of you virtually at several upcoming conference annual meetings this fall! In the meantime, please find below a market summary from our Chief Investment Strategist, David Klassen, and a few updates from UCF.

"Global financial markets continued to be positive in the third quarter led by emerging markets. The strength of large cap securities in the U.S. resulted in a positive YTD return for the S&P 500. This is against a backdrop of continued economic uncertainty due to the coronavirus outbreak and the U.S. presidential election. For the third quarter, large cap stocks (S&P 500) returned 8.93%, and small cap stocks (Russell 2000 Index) were up 4.93%. International developed stocks were up 4.80% for the quarter, and emerging market equities were up 9.56%.

"Fixed income returns were positive within all strategies, led by riskier credit strategies particularly in the U.S. The U.S. 10-year Treasury yield fluctuated between 0.52% and 0.74% and ended the quarter at 0.69%. Third quarter performance for the Barclays Government Credit Index, a proxy for the broad U.S. fixed income market, was up 0.78%; bank loans were up 4.14%; and emerging market debt was up 2.28%."
