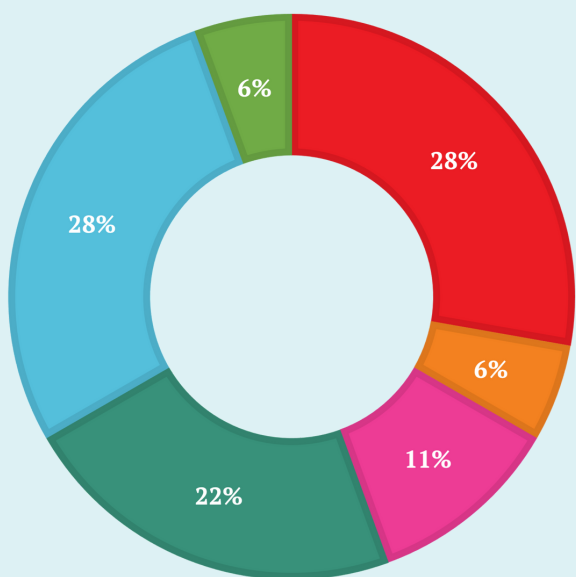

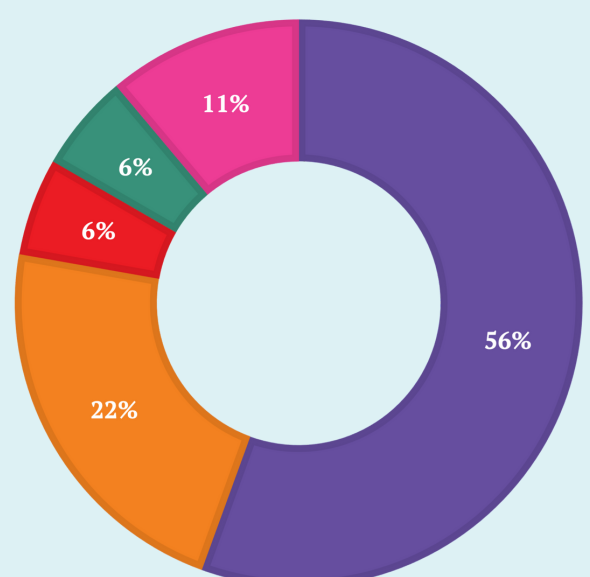
UCC Conferences represented by Brown Scholars

The Helen and Richard Brown Endowment for Pastoral Scholarships derives from a generous gift received in the 1990s, designated to support pastoral ministry in the UCC. United Church Funds serves as trustee of the Brown Endowment, helping to ensure funding for pastoral education and development. Since its inception, the initial gift of \$5 million now provides over \$300,000 annually to UCC conferences, seminaries and global partners, providing individual scholarships for seminarians, grants for continuing education for authorized ministries and support for seminarians in UCC/Disciples global partner churches.
